Take notes as you read the Scripture each day. Reflect on the verses and apply them to your life.

Day 1—Read Matthew 27:32-44. ➤

- Why did they give Jesus “wine mixed with gall” to drink?
- What was the official charge against Jesus? Why did the people mock Jesus?
- What does Jesus’ willingness to undergo this kind of treatment mean to you?

Day 2—Read Matthew 27:45-56. ➤

- What is the significance of the curtain being split top to bottom?
- What is the significance of the bodies of the saints coming out of their tombs?
- What is the significance of the centurions’ comment in verse 54?
- How will the death of Jesus impact you today?

Day 3—Read Matthew 27:57-61. ➤

- Why did Joseph ask for Jesus’ body? What did Joseph do to secure the tomb of Jesus?
- Why can we be sure that Mary and Mary Magdalene knew where the tomb was?
- Why is it important to verify that Jesus really was buried?

Day 4—Read Matthew 27:62-66. ➤

- Who wanted a guard at the tomb and why? Who gave the order for there to be a guard? How long was the guard to stay at the tomb and why?
- What is the significance of sealing the stone at the tomb?
- What does it mean to you today that the tomb of Jesus was secure?

Day 5—Read Matthew 28:1-10. ➤

- Who came to the tomb on Sunday morning? Who was sitting on the stone?
- What did the angel tell the two women?
- Who met the women as they ran away from the tomb? What did He tell the women?
- What do these verses mean to you?

Day 6—Read Matthew 28:11-15. ➤

- Who did the guard report to? What was the priest’s plan? What were the guards to say?
- What story has been passed down among the Jewish people?
- Why does the story about the disciples stealing Jesus’ body while the guard slept not make sense?

Day 7—Read Matthew 28:16-20. ➤

- Who has all authority?
- In verse 19, what does Jesus command us to do?
- Why is it important to teach new believers to observe everything Jesus commanded?
- What promise does Jesus make for those carrying out His command? How willing are you to carry out this command?
